

Competition Brief: CHILDREN'S WARD SELECTION NIGHT Wednesday 6 November 2019

THEME

The theme for this competition is CHILDREN'S WARD SELECTION NIGHT

JUDGE

Images are selected by judges (local primary school students) invited from various local schools.

BACKGROUND INFO

25 selected photos from the night will be displayed in the local Hawkesbury District Hospital - Children's Ward in 2020 for 12 months. Selected images will be printed by the Club.

DEFINITION

The subject is open. Images must be suitable for children to view (i.e. 0 to 13 years)

Judges on the night will be a group of local primary school children. Members should approach this comp differently. The judges do not care about the technicality, rules of thirds, composition, contrast, cropping etc. The best way to approach this photo selection evening is to put yourself in the mind of a primary age child, what would appeal to them? These images should cheer up kids that may be in hospital, sick or recuperating. What would cheer them up?

Electronic files <u>must be</u> submitted with your entries. 'HIGH RESOLUTION' IMAGES must be supplied on a USB labelled with your name.

Please also bear in mind that selected photos will be donated to the hospital. If you do not want your image (if selected) being displayed in the hospital – do not enter this competition. CATEGORIES

There is only 1 category (combined A and B Grade) for this competition. You may enter up to 4 prints (no digital) colour or monochrome - image size minimum A4 and maximum A3, see requirements. NO SQUARE FORMATS.

REQUIREMENTS

High res digital copies should also be submitted on the night and conform to our normal guidelines for naming images. Low res images are not suitable. Only financial members can enter.

All images submitted for this competition must have been taken within the last 2 years from the competition date.

Due to the frames that are used in the hospital, prints $\underline{\text{must be}}$ A4 21 x 29.7cm (8.27 x 11.69 inches) so they can enlarge to the frames A3 29.7 x 42cm (11.69 x 16.53 inches).

To be held on Wednesday 6 November 2019 at **6.30pm for 7pm** start at Richmond Club, Francis Street, Richmond. All entries must be on the stands by 6.45pm and any late entries might not be allowed. This is to accommodate the students.
