FROM THE PRESIDENT

Well here we are in October 2013. Two months & three comps left for the year.

Our October comp is the "Digital Manipulation" comp, so all the Photoshop & Lightroom experts in the club need not hold back. Recently we heard about the three parts of photography, taking, making and shaking. Which one will you be? One requirement for the comp is that you show us the original image that you started with.

The first of our two comps in November is on the 6th and is the annual Childrens' Ward comp. For this comp, you should approach you entries differently, very differently. We do not have usual camera club judges for this comp. Rather, our judges will be a group of primary school children who do not care two hoots about rules of thirds, leading lines, composition, contrast, burnt out highlights, cropping, or anything else we usually here about. The best way to approach this comp is to put yourself in the mind of a primary school student, lying in a hospital bed for any length of time with any sort of ailment or injury and looking at the same photo on the wall each day. What would you want that photo to be???

Two very important aspects bring out the individuality of this comp. The first is that the chosen prints will replace the photos already in the ward. Those "outgoing" prints are then sold, with the proceeds being donated to the Childrens' Ward. So if one or more of your entries are chosen as the new "ingoing" prints, please have the attitude that you are kissing them good bye to a happy home somewhere, you can always get a copy anyway!!!

The second aspect which is out of our control, although we do try to do something about it, has become affectionately known as "The People's Choice" award. This is a very sad possibility that could happen at any time in the coming twelve months. How is it awarded? Easy, someone steals your photo, right off the hospital wall!!!! Don't laugh, it has happened twice to date in recent years. One person at least put the empty frame back on the wall; the other took the frame as well. So if you get this award, stand tall and be proud, someone wants your photo bad enough that they will steal it out of the Childrens' Ward in the hospital.

Our final comp for the year will be our End of Year comp late in November. This is our big night when all the awards get handed out. The main rule for this comp is **“NO NEW WORK”**.
