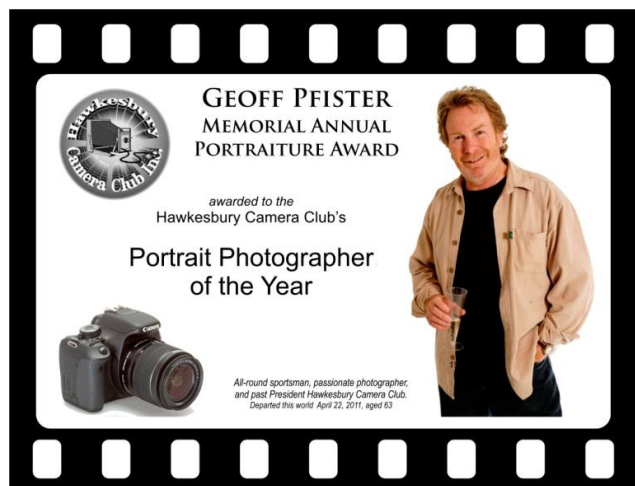

Thanks to everyone who helps continues the annual event.



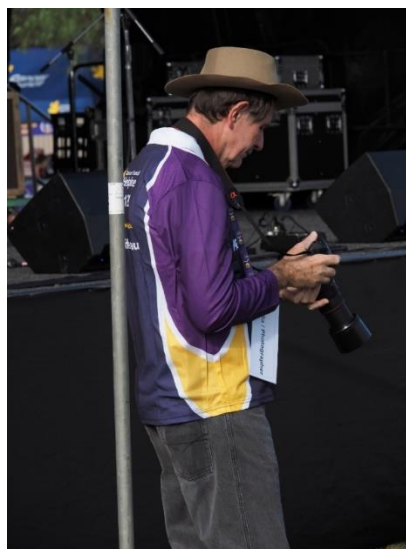
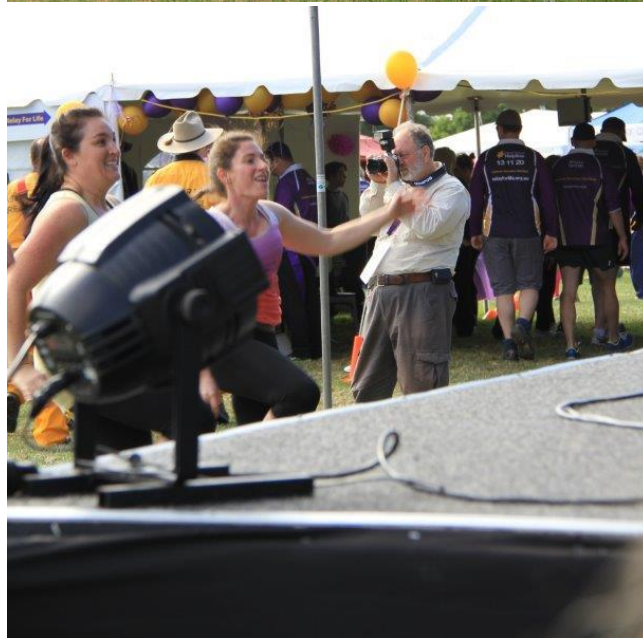
RELAY FOR LIFE 2015 – 23RD & 24TH MAY

The 'Hawkesbury Relay for Life' was held at Hawkesbury Showground in the last weekend of May. This is a fund raising event with all proceeds going to assist in cancer research. The official opening was 9.30am Saturday morning, and official closing was at 9.30am Sunday morning.

Relay For Life is a fun and moving overnight experience. This relay is a chance for the Hawkesbury community to recognise and celebrate local cancer survivors, patients and their carers, to honour and remember loved ones lost to cancer and to raise money to help save more lives

There were 56 teams, 613 participants and \$98,454.18 were raised.

Our camera club was invited for the 3rd year to photograph the event for them and the efforts of our 3 members who attended at various times were greatly appreciated by their committee.

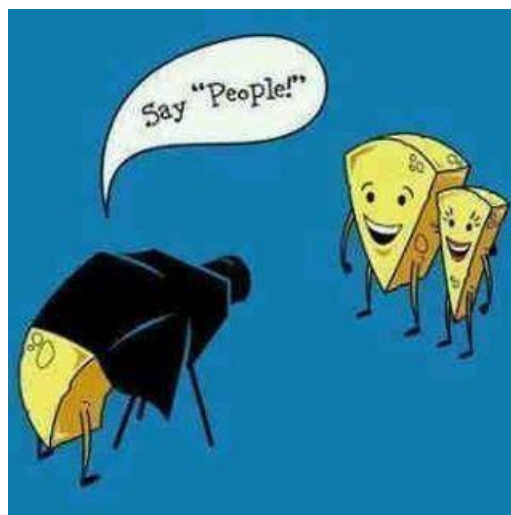
